Critique

I would like to thank The Samoyed Club for the opportunity to judge your 2019 Championship Show.

Firstly, I must thank the exhibitors for the entry and the way they took my decisions.

I was very impressed with the consistency in size, feet and tails with your Samoyeds, these are things I feel are issues in Australia.

Thank you to Simeon, who is a wonderful host, and the tour of Wellington when I arrived, I thoroughly enjoyed.

I had only one disappointment from the show, I know we have all shown our Sams to some degree out of coat, however no matter how well constructed or how good a bitch moves a Samoyed with absolutely no coat or feathering can never be considered, and I believe all it does is takes away from the bitch.

I was extremely disappointed when this bitch came into the Open Bitch class as it was a bitch I had awarded and admired when she was in Australia.

Baby Dog (1 entry)

1st - Exh 1 RYAZANZ CIRCLE OF LIFE – Baby in Show

This baby was a pleasure to judge, from his good head, feet, angulation and movement, which was not close behind, he showed himself off very well whilst still being a baby. It was a pleasure to award this boy Baby in Show. And he is one I will take an interest in as he matures.

Puppy Dog (4 entries – 1 absent)

1st – Exh 5 - OSCARBI ASTRO-NAUT BOY – Res Dog CC & RUNNER UP & PUPPY in SHOW

This 7 mth old puppy came into the ring and owned it, balanced with a good head, ears, eyes but would prefer a better foot and the handler to drop the head a little on the stack. Moved well. Overall a very nice puppy and one to watch.

2nd – Exh 4 – KURSHARN WITCH-WOLF

8 mth old puppy balanced, good head, eyes with slightly larger ear, good feet a nice puppy just a little willful. Very close between 1st & 2nd.

3rd – Exh 2 – KALISA SHINING-LIGHT OF SUNSHINE

11mth old boy, ready to move up a class. Good angulation, good coat changed from puppy fluff, good head, just a little bit long for me.

Limit Dog (2 entries)

1st – Exh 7 – ZAMINKA POLAR VOYAGE – **Limit in Show**

A young male in good coat, with good head, expression and feet. Up there in size but balanced. Young handler who did a wonderful job and had him showing all the time.

2nd – Exh 6 – KELLJASS SPRING SHOWSTOPPER

A heavier style of dog, good head with small ears, not as free in movement as the winner.

New Zealand Bred Dog – (3 entries)

1st – Exh 12 - KURSHARN VAMPING-COOPER – **New Zealand Bred in Show**

3yr old dog in quality good coat, balanced angulation with a good reach of neck, good head, expression and feet, moved effortlessly.

2nd – Exh 10 – CH OSCARBI IT'S BEST SERVED COLD

Nearly 5-year-old male in good coat, good head and reach of neck, moved well, however would like a little better angulation.

3rd – Exh 11 – CH SAMONARCH TOUCH THE SKY

4.7-year-old, a heavier style than the others in this class, good coat and head, would prefer a little more reach of neck.

Veteran Dog – (2 entries)

1st – Exh 14 – GR & SPL GR CH OSCARBI EVEREDI BOY – **Veteran in Show**

8-year-old who went around the ring like he owned it. Balanced angulation, good feet, reach of neck, good head with expression, good coat texture.

2nd – Exh 13 – CH OSCARBI BACKIN THE FUTURE AT KALISA

7-year-old who is a bit heavier than the winner, good head and expression, balanced angulation with good feet. Would like a little more neck. Was out moved by the winner.

Open Dog (4 entries 2 absent)

1st – Exh 17 – GR CH ZAMINKA CAT AMONGST PIGEONS – **Dog CC, BEST EXHIBIT & OPEN in SHOW**

This boy came in the ring and I thought this is the one to beat. He is everything I like and want in a Samoyed.

Good movement coming and going, covered the ground going around without exaggeration, good coat, head, ears, eyes all blended. Good reach of neck, angulation and feet good. Tail correct. A top-quality dog and one I would be happy to have in my backyard.

2ND – Exh 16 – OSCARBI LORDE IN THE RING

4-year-old boy who was unfortunate to be in this class, good head, slightly larger ears, good coat, angulation balanced with good reach of neck, a smidge longer in body than the winner.

Baby Bitch (2 entries)

1st – Exh 19 – RYAZANZ CAN-YOU-FEEL-DA-LUV-TNITE

Litter sister to the Baby dog, think perhaps a little more work has been put into the dog, another very nice baby, good feet, angulation but just not as eye catching as the dog.

2nd – Exh 18 – KELLJASS AN ANGEL SO TRUE

A baby bitch who is ready to go into minor, angulation, tail and feet good. Moved very well. However, would like a slightly smaller eye

Puppy Bitch (2 entries)

1st – Exh 21 – ZAMINKA ROCK STAR – **Res Bitch CC**

A pretty girl of good size with correct head, eye and ear, good coat. Angulation and tail correct, moved well.

2nd – Exh 20 – KALISA THIS LIL LIGHT OF MINE

A 11mth old girl, a little up on size, good head, lacking a bit of coat but she is of that age, good feet and tail. Would like a bit more angulation.

Junior Bitch (3 entries)

1st – Exh 23 – ANAKY THIS IS ME (IMP AUST) – **Junior in Show**

This girl was another a little up on size, angulation balanced with good feet & tail. Good reach of neck with a correct head with good eyes & ears. Moved well

2nd – Exh 24 – CH ZAMINKA VIVA LAS VEGAS

A heavier and slightly longer girl than the winner, a pretty head and expression. Adequate movement, good feet and tail.

3rd – Exh 22 – CH KURSHARN WITCHES-WITCH

This girl was also a little longer than the winner, however angulation, feet & tail were all good, and another pretty head but would like a slightly smaller ear. Adequate movement.

Intermediate Bitch (4 entries 2 absent)

1st – Exh 26 – CH SUNSHINE REM'BER JALEE – **Intermediate in Show**

Balanced angulation with a short loin, not in full coat but correct, good feet and head, would prefer a smaller ear, but with a fuller coat that could change. Moved well.

2nd – Exh 30 – CH OSCARBI LORDE IT OVER KID

A longer girl, with good angulation would refer a bit more neck, good head, feet and tail.

Limit Bitch (3 entries)

1st – Exh 32 – OSCARI SWISH SWISH BISH

7 mth old pretty head, good tail, would prefer more angulation and better feet. Moved and showed well.

2nd – Exh 25 – KELLJASS SPRING-ANGEL

This was a nice bitch who had not long had surgery so was a bit unsure of me going over her. Good head and feet. Tail set could be better. A little longer than 1st.

3rd – Exh 31 - KURSHARN WICKED-WITCH AT SHEIDINICE

Another nice bitch, that was also a little longer, good expression, coat and feet. Would also like a better tail set.

New Zealand Bred Bitch – (5 entries 1 absent)

1st – Exh 34 – CH ZAMINKA ONE NIGHT STAND

6-year-old who went around the ring liked she owned it, good coat, correct head, good angulation, correct tail and feet.

2nd – Exh 35 – CH KURSHARN GOLDEN-WITCH

Another 6-year-old who went around well, slightly lighter than 1st, good coat, good reach of neck and angulation. Correct tail and feet.

3rd – Exh 28 – CH OSCARBI JUST LIKE YA

2-year-old a little too heavy for me at this age, slightly longer and would like a little more neck. Good head, feet and tail.

Veteran Bitch – (2 entries)

1st – Exh 37 – CH SUNSHINE AUTUMN-GOLD

7-year-old of balanced angulation, good feet & tail. Good head and reach of neck. Adequate movement

2nd - Exh 38 – CH ZAMINKA DIAMONDS FOREVER

9-year-old with a lovely head and expression, however I would prefer more leg. Good feet and tail. Movement showed her age a bit.

Open Bitch (5 entries 1 absent)

1st – Exh 41 – CH OSCARBI UNMISTAKABLY MOI – **Bitch CC**

5-year-old pretty, showy bitch with correct angulation and good reach of neck. Feet, tail and head good. Moved well.

2nd – Exh 40 – NZ CH ANAKY SAY YOU LOVE ME (IMP AUST)

6-year-old a bitch slightly longer than 1st, balanced angulation, good reach of neck, correct feet good head but again I would like a smaller ear. Movement balanced.

3rd – Exh 42 – CH SUNSHINE DREAM-COME TRUE AT KALISA

5-year-old Correct head and eyes, good coat, feet, reach of neck and tail. However, would like a slightly better lay of shoulder. Moved adequately.
